



## EASY TO USE • ON/OFF SWITCH • NO MESS APPLICATION

**DO NOT** spray if weeds are wilted by dry or cold weather. **DO NOT** apply if shade temperatures are expected to exceed 30°C within a 72 hour period. **DO NOT** spray if rain is expected within 4 hours. **DO NOT** mow grass for 2 days after treatment.

### HOW TO USE

#### SITUATION

Lawns - established Buffalo (except ST varieties), Couch (including QLD Blue Couch), Bent, Fescue, Kikuyu, Paspalum and Ryegrass

#### WEEDS CONTROLLED

Bindii, capeweed, cats ear, clover (not TAS), creeping buttercup, cudweed, dandelion, fleabane, jo-jo (onehunga), oxalis, plantain, thistles

#### RATE

Apply 2.0L over 130m<sup>2</sup>

**HOW TO APPLY:** Measure lawn before application. Apply evenly over the area to be treated. Weeds die slowly; effects may take 3 weeks to appear. Repeat application may be required to control advanced weeds or certain types of clover. Slight browning of grasses may occur.

### HOW TO APPLY



#### 1. CONNECT

- Shake well before use
- Attach sprayer to hose and turn on water
- Extend hose to the farthest point of the area to be fed

#### 2. WEED, FEED & GREEN

- Slide the thumb switch to the ON position to weed & feed your lawn or slide to WATER position to just water your lawn
- Walk slowly using a sweeping action to distribute the spray evenly over the measured lawn area
- When finished, switch to OFF position and turn off water

**CAUTION:** Before use on new varieties of buffalo, test on a small area first. **DO NOT** allow spray to contact or drift onto plants you do not want to kill. **DO NOT** apply within the dripline of shallow rooted trees or shrubs or apply the product in areas where the chemical may be washed into contact with roots of desirable plants. **DO NOT** allow entry (including pets) into treated area until spray has dried. **DO NOT** allow chemical containers or spray to get into drains, sewers, streams or ponds. **DO NOT** feed grass clippings from treated areas to poultry or other animals or use to mulch plants.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in the closed, original container in a cool, dry place out of the reach of children. Do not store in direct sunlight. Dispose of empty container by wrapping in paper, placing in plastic bag and putting in garbage.

**SAFETY DIRECTIONS:** Product is poisonous if inhaled or swallowed. Attacks the eyes and will irritate the skin. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not inhale spray mist. When using the prepared spray wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist, washable hat and elbow-length PVC gloves. If product on skin, immediately wash area with soap and water. If product in eyes, wash it out immediately with water. After use and before eating, drinking or smoking wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water. After each days use, wash gloves and contaminated clothing.
