Apply anytime of year. For best results feed three times per year.

## **HOW MUCH WILL I NEED?**



as you use less to feed more. To determine the size of your lawn in m<sup>2</sup>, multiply

the length by the width in metres.

- → ¼ of a tennis court equals approx 65m²
- ½ of a tennis court equals approx 130m²
- You will need to apply 16g/m<sup>2</sup> of your lawn.





### **HOW DO I APPLY IT?**

### **DRY METHOD**

During water restriction periods, apply to lawn without watering in. Scotts Lawn Builder is safe on lawn until next rain or watering when evenly and correctly applied with a spreader. Guaranteed to green the lawn within one week of obtaining moisture.

### **FAST METHOD**

Greener in 2 days with watering. For fast results apply to moist foliage, wait 24 hours then water in thoroughly.

Fertiliser application should be avoided if temperature is expected to exceed 30°C. For best results use a Scotts Spreader, however if applying by hand ensure even distribution.

NOTE: Setting 4 on the Easy Handheld spreader applies half the recommended rate. If using the Easy HandHeld, move over the entire area in one direction at a slow, steady walking pace then repeat application in a perpendicular direction to give full even coverage

Easy HandHeld Spreader

- Sweep excess granules off paths, driveways, shoes, etc. to avoid iron stains. See important note below.
- Do not use on a new lawn less than 8 weeks old. Use Lawn Builder Starter Fertiliser instead.
- Use half of the suggested rate for summer application on cool season grasses, e.g. Bent Grass.
- Scotts Lawn Builder is not recommended for use on other plants.

This product when wet, will cause iron stains. Be sure to sweep all granules off paths, coping, paving, driveways, shoes, etc. immediately after use. Do not allow the granules to come into contact with these
