

HOW TO USE: DO NOT burn off, cut or clear for 6 months after treatment.

SITUATION/ SPRAY METHOD	WEEDS CONTROLLED	MIXING RATE	HOW TO APPLY
Overall spraying	Blackberry, Camphor Laurel seedlings (up to 3m tall)	20 ml per 1 litre of water	Apply from late spring to early autumn when bushes are actively growing. Wet all foliage and stems thoroughly. Any regrowth and seedlings should be sprayed after hardening. Do not spray blackberries suffering from drought stress. Tas: Do not spray bushes carrying mature or near mature fruit.
Basal bark spraying and cut stump treatment	Gorse (not Tas) Wattles Groundsel bush	20 ml to 40 ml per 1 litre water	Apply from Spring to mid-Summer when growth is active. Use higher rate on older gorse bushes, tall wattles and Groundsel bushes. Spray to wet all foliage and stems thoroughly. Retreatment of gorse regrowth may be necessary.
	Eucalyptus and Wattle seedlings and suckers, Camphor Laurel (not Vic and Tas), Australian blackthorn, Lantana, African Boxthorn	100 ml per 500 ml of kerosene	Basal Bark Spraying: for treatment of seedlings up to 5 cm diameter (up to 10 cm for Camphor Laurel, Groundsel bushes and Privet). Spray or paint bark or round stem to 30 cm wetting thoroughly. Old rough bark may require more thorough spraying than young, smooth bark.
	Privet	100 ml per 250 ml of kerosene 100 ml per 100 ml of kerosene	Cut stump treatment: Apply to freshly cut stems of suckers and seedlings more than 5 cm in basal diameter. Cut stems or trunks to within 1.5cm of the ground. Apply liberally by spraying or painting. Do not treat Australian blackthorn during dormant period.

HOW TO PREPARE:

Clean equipment thoroughly with soap and water after use. Equipment that has been used for this herbicide should not be used for the application of other materials to sensitive plants. Grasses are usually unaffected and establish quickly after treatment.

CAUTION:

DO NOT allow chemical containers or spray to get into drains, sewers, streams or ponds.
DO NOT allow spray to contact or drift onto plants you do not want killed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in the closed, original container in a cool, dry place out of the reach of children. DO NOT store in direct sunlight. Dispose of empty container by wrapping in paper, placing in plastic bag and putting in garbage.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS:

Poisonous if swallowed. May irritate the eyes and skin. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. When opening the container and preparing spray and using the prepared spray wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist and a washable hat and elbow-length rubber gloves.
